Proper Dress for Graduation: Option A

- Dress shorter than the gown
- Black dress shoes (must have a heel strap)
- No large earrings or necklaces
- If you have a concern about appropriate shoes, see Ms. Hefner, Ms. Allen, or Mrs. Grier

Proper Dress for Graduation: Option B

- White or light blue dress shirt
- Dark conservative tie (NO bow ties)
- Solid dark dress pants
- Dark Socks
- Black dress shoes







How to wear cap/gown & cords



- Tassel on the right
- Layer:
 - Magnet Stole,
 - then Honor Cords,
 - then NHS Stole.
- Return Magnet Stoles at the end of Graduation when marching out.
- When you get home, take your gown out of the packaging and let it hang to release the wrinkles. (Do <u>not</u> iron the gown & do <u>not</u> decorate caps)



Reminders for Graduation Day

- Preferred: Ask a family member to hold on to student purses, keys, & cell phones.
- If keys & cell phones are necessary, they must be brought in a zip lock bag that is already labeled in permanent marker with your name on the bag.
- Be careful who you invite!
 You are responsible for the behavior of your guests.
 (Community Service)
- NO BANNERS, No Noise Makers, No Balloons, No sectioning off seats.

- Clear purses ONLY!
- All guests must have a ticket (including babies). Limited handicap seating.
- Park in Lot B of the Civic Center (right side in front of Ice Rink). Must enter parking lot via Lumpkin Rd.




